Lack of coronal seal can lead to endodontic failure. Coronal leakage can occur at any time right from the beginning of endodontic treatment, till the postendodontic restoration is completed. The lesser the time duration between access cavity preparation and permanent restoration, the lesser will be the leakage.

Access cavity preparation is one of the most important steps of root canal treatment . In a traditional endodontic cavity (TEC) procedure, the aim is to have the pulpal chamber and pulpal horns in the access cavity to increase the efficiency of preparation, to establish a straight access path to the root canals, and to ensure effective preparation of coronal sections of root canals [5 , 7 , 8].

Following these trends, the access procedures in endodontics and the root canal preparation are changing in a conservative way, sometimes drastically if compared with the traditional concepts of cavity outline opening and coronal straight-line access to reach the apical region.
