Provide the author, year of publication, title, and publisher of the book. Include any edition information in parentheses after the title, without italics. If the book includes a DOI, include the DOI in the reference after the publisher name. Do not include the publisher location.

Title of chapter/section (in single quotation marks) 'in' plus author/editor of book. Title of book (in italics). Place of publication: publisher.

To begin, immediately following a quotation or a paraphrase, APA citation style requires an in-text citation. Typically, these in-text references include the author's last name, followed by a comma and the year. You do not need to include the title of the chapter for most in-text citations.
